  - Once enrollment limits are reached, youth will be placed on a waiting list
- Because of the high interest for this club, the following participation policy will be enforced:
  - If youth miss two consecutive meetings without letting Jordan know in advance and the reason why, they will be removed from the club roster and the next person on the waiting list will be allowed to join





# Meeting Schedule
