Red Sheepnose (aka Crow Egg, deep, black-red skin when fully ripe, ripens in September-October)		\$20	
Yellow Bellflower (lemon yellow color and pinkish-blush in sunny exposures, ripens in October)		\$20	
Virginia Beauty (glossy red or purplish color, ripens in October)		\$20	
Yellow June (aka Yellow Transparent, bright yellow upon full ripening, ripens in late June-early July)		\$20	
Honeycrisp (Mottled red skin over a yellow background, ripens in late August)		\$20	
Wolf River (Pale yellow skin covered with pale red coloring, ripens in July)		\$20	
Hawkeye (the parent tree of the Red Delicious variety. Green-skinned dessert apple with red stripes, elongated and red in color.)		\$20	
Carolina Red June (small fruit, deep red skin covers yellow fruit, ripens late June into July)		\$20	
Old Timey Striped June (aka Margaret, small-medium, yellow skin/dark red striping, ripens June to July)		\$20	
Cammack's Sweet (dull, yellow, usually with a blush cheek, mottled with green russet and scarfed skin. Ripens in Sept.-Oct.)		\$20	
Newtown Pippin (yellow with a pink blush, and the flesh is yellow, firm, crisp, juicy, and subacid. Ripens in October)		\$20	
Junaluska (yellow, lightly shaded on the sunny side, and sprinkled with brown and gray dots, ripens in Oct. and Nov.)		\$20	
Jonagold (Orange-red blush to yellowish-green color, ripens in September)		\$20	
Summer Banana (deep yellow with small light green splotches. Faint banana smell if it is fully ripe. Ripens from Aug. to Sept.)		\$20	
Victoria Limbertwig (purple skin with white dots and crisp yellow flesh, ripens in mid-September to late October)		\$20
