Registration will open on Monday, April 29th at 9:00am.

After this time, you may register your child in-person at the Yancey County Cooperative Extension Office. Our office is open Monday-Friday, 8:00am-4:30pm. Registration will be on a first-come, first-serve basis. Registrations will not be accepted via phone or online. Register only one child per

form.

How to register:

- 1. **Before registration is turned in:** Enroll as a 4-H member using our online enrollment called 4-H Online (v2.4honline.com). Once this is complete, youth can participate in any 4-H summer camps, clubs or programs!
- 2. Complete this registration form (printed forms are also available at the office)
- 3. **Bring registration form and payment** (cash or check made to Yancey County 4-H) to the Yancey County Cooperative Extension Office (30 East U.S Hwy 19 E Bypass, Burnsville, NC 28714). Payment is due in full at time of registration to reserve your space! See registration policies on the reverse side for more information.

After You Have Registered:

- Please mark your calendars for the camps your child has registered for. Email reminders may be sent out, but do not rely on this as your only reminder!
- Accommodation requests related to a disability must be made at least 3 weeks prior to the camp to Jordan English at 828-682-6186 or jordan english@ncsu.edu
- If your child has an epi-pen for any allergies, they MUST bring this to the camp(s) they attend.
- If your child will be taking any medication (prescription or over-the-counter) during a 4-H camp, please advise the 4-H staff and supply medication in the original container, with authorization form, for the leader to be responsible for.
- Please be on time for drop-off and pick-up! Many camps have busy schedules and we are unable to wait for late campers when departing for trips away from the office.
- Pay close attention to the "what to bring" section listed under each camp. Some camps require special attire, lunch to be packed and other special requests.
- Space is limited, so once enrolled, your child is expected to attend and participate. If your child can no
 longer attend, please contact the 4-H Office as soon as possible so we can offer the space to the
 waitlist.
- We are not able to offer refunds for withdrawals or missed camps.
- Due to NC law, 4-H staff are not allowed to supply or install car seats. If a car seat or booster seat is needed, please provide one and place it in the County van. Your child's safety is very important to us!
